Originally published in Williams played Lovesick Blues on Louisiana Hayride (1948). Released in 1959, He'll Have To Go reached the top of both the country and pop music charts. The Dance was a track on Brooks' self-titled 1989 album. The song is a personal favorite of Brooks. Sixteen Tons was first recorded in 1946. Tennessee Ernie Ford released a version in 1955 that reached Number one on the charts. Recorded in 1938, New San Antonio Rose became a song for which Bob Wills and his Texas Playboys were known. Workin' Man Blues was released in 1969 and is a tribute from Haggard to his fans. This song, which in many ways is a Signature Cash song, was released in 1957. It is inducted into the Grammy Hall of Fame. In 1968, Mama Tried was awarded the Grammy Hall of Fame Award. Coal Miner's Daughter was inducted into the Grammy Award Hall of Fame in 1970. Old Dogs, Children, and Watermelon Wine debuted in 1972. It reached the third place in the country music charts. Always On My Mind was released in 1982. It is the title track for the album of the same name. Oh, Lonesome Me was released in 1958. It reached number 7 on the Billboard 100. Tiger by the Tail became a top song for Buck Owens in 1964.
